Involved! Our Junior and Senior High youth have more things on their plates than we ourselves might have ever imagined, yet at Grace we make critical investments in their faith lives.





Client numbers continue to dwarf anything seen in recent years. With a 40% surge in clients in 2022 and an almost 50% surge in 2023 so far, we are challenged to maintain our level of services. The generosity of the people of Grace has proven up to the challenge! Through July of 2023 we increased our giving by more than \$15,000 over the same period last year. We feed a lot of hungry people!


