

We invite you to pray for Grace Lutheran Church.



Ministry Initiatives

With an additional \$10,600 (\$204 per week) we will be able to continue and expand the following ministries and mission.

Grow in Faith:

At Grace, young people grow in their relationship with God. They learn to Love God and Serve Others in all they do. This nurtures the congregation and allows the church to flourish.

In the coming year we will expand the impact we have on our youth as we:

- Allow for seven of our high school youth to participate in the 2024 ELCA Youth Gathering in New Orleans
- Provide support for participation in Crossways
 Confirmation Camp (Junior High Youth) and Leadership
 Lab (Senior High Youth) at Augustana College
- Provide the opportunity to attend the CSIS Youth Gathering in Carlinville
- Encourage our High School youth to take an active role in the Holiday Happening, leading the youngest children at Grace.

Grow in Music Ministry: At Grace, we sing together. It's at the core of our identity. Through music we experience God's love for everyone.

The college-aged, young professional musicians who provide beautiful music for worship meet Grace members who are genuinely interested in their lives and welcoming of their faith journey. Young people hear plenty these days about judgmental, legalistic churches. We show we are something entirely different than that. We show...Grace!

In the coming year we will invest in our music ministry as we:

- Provide funding for 1-2 additional singers in the choir
- Have guest instrumentalists of all kinds join us on a more regular basis

Grow in Serving Others: The Food Pantry at Grace provides an outward expression of our passion for caring for the least of our brothers and sisters. Food insecurity plagues Springfield. Grace will continue doing something about it!

In the coming year we will:

- Help our clients locate other food pantries and micro pantries for the additional support they need
- Broaden our base of large donors
- Seek further grants from corporate Springfield
